GRAND REWARD away in good order, cleared through a leisurely opening quarter, continued to set soft fractions the middle half, felt the whip in the second turn while continued clear, just enough to hold the runner up safe in the late going. SECOND OF JUNE closest to the winner throughout while off the inside, set down for the drive, drifted out a bit past the furlong marker, getting to winner, missed. EDDINGTON well off the soft pace, three wide into the lane, not enough for the top two in the late going. CROWNED KING fell back to trail, moved out a bit, nipped LIMEHOUSE for the fourth position while never a threat for the win. LIMEHOUSE broke in the air, recovered to save ground within striking distance, weakened.
