COWBOY CADILLAC toward the front while off the inside, three wide into the stretch, took over, got clear, held the runner up safe late. GAME PLAY'S ICON pulled while behind the pace toward the inside, shuffled back far turn, moved out, late bid, denied. SO BUSTED void of speed, began to advance into the far turn, improved, moved out, 4w into lane, appeared to lug in slightly nearing the furlong grounds, moved out, mild rally for the show. RAVENSWORTH pressured the early pace, fell back while inside through the second turn, moved out for the drive, behind horses, lacked a kick when clear. MINIMAST pressed or dueled up front off the inside for just over six furlongs and then had little left for the drive. BORDEAUX BANDIT carried wide into the first turn, continued back, managed some mild, belated interest in the three path. WHO'S HUSSONET settled in the middle of the pack early, lacked a response in the drive. VALISE set or forced the pace closest to the inside, faltered in the drive. MOMENTARILY four wide through both turns, failed to rally. YEP five wide

trip, outrun. LIFE'S LESSONS rank at the start, gave way, pulled up, vanned off.
