VALHOL, away in good order, pressed the leader off the inside, put a head in front entering the far turn, got clear soon after and maintained a considerable advantage through the lane under steady pressure. CERTAIN, void of early foot, made a good gain three wide in the second turn then could do little with the winner the final quarter. TORRID SAND allowed the pace to go early, came three wide into the stretch, lugged out a bit to brush with ECTON PARK past the furlong marker then outfinished that same rival for the show. ECTON PARK, last away, trailed for five furlongs, advanced four wide into the stretch, was brushed by TORRID SAND with a furlong remaining then went evenly to the wire. ANSWER LIVELY, four wide while within striking distance through the first turn, continued to stalk on the outside down the backstretch, was called on for some run in the second bend and came up empty. ETBAUER lost his footing at the start, saved ground through the first turn, made a mild gain along the rail down the backstretch then gave way with three furlongs to run. SAINT'S HONOR set the pace off the inside until headed by the winner into the far turn and stopped.
