FILLIES, THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made by closing time of entries at a fee of \$3,000 which qualifies to start. \$25,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for CUP ELIGIBLES ONLY. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an award position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. WEIGHTS: 121 lbs.

Non-winners of \$30,000 at one mile or over in 2004 allowed 3 lbs.; \$20,000 at any distance in 20004 allowed 5 lbs.; \$18,000 at any time allowed 7 lbs.; \$12,500 at any time allowed 9 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered). This race will not be divided.

Preference will be given in the following order: Breeders' Cup nominees only of equal racing quality or weight assignment (Respective of sex and weight for age).

TEE'S PEARL away well, rated comfortably while clear setting the pace, maintained a daylight advantage to win ridden out. PILFER lacked early foot, angled out a bit to come five wide into the stretch, finished willingly for the place while not a threat for the win. CEDAR SUMMER last away, trailed, enjoyed a golden trip along the rail, outfinished for the place. JOSIE G. within striking distance toward the inside, lacked a winning response. MISS WELLSPRING in the second flight four wide turning for home, also came up empty when the real running started. PLATINUM HEIGHTS within striking distance off the inside, no bid. CRYPTOS' BEST lwas finished early. MISS CONCERTO pressed the winner for six furlongs, gave way in the drive.
