INDIAN BLOSSOM unhurried in the early going, managed a steady gain through the second turn, challenged between foes with a furlong to run, outfinished. LIKE CANDY allowed to settle, lodged a mild bid four wide turning for home, flattened out, saved the show. HIDDEN VALUE set the pace along the inside after an alert break, weakened in the drive. BAR BABE void of early foot, advanced four wide into the lane, failed to sustain that advance in the lane. ONE FOR JIM last away, raced back, made little impact. CONNECT TO ME chased the leader early, began to weaken after a half. ENJOY THE SCORE had nothing for the drive. MISSY BISCUIT was finished after a half. KAYLA DO trailed throughout.
