SAPRISTI lacked speed, steady advance through traffic second turn, late kick to be clear late. ZIPPIT HONEY dueled up front closest to the inside, shook well clear, lugged when straightened for home, caught in the late going. SAFE void of early foot, rallied four wide out of the final turn in traffic, continued willingly to the finish to be getting to the runner up. BANDUCCI settled off the pace, moved closer three wide, flattened out a bit in the drive. ORO GATITA lacked speed, improved position while not a threat. PRINCESS MEG lacked a rally. BEAUTIFUL CHAMPION last away, passed some tiring foes while racing toward the inside. MOLLY WILL PASS settled early, five wide late in the second turn, tired. DARK AND BEAUTIFUL forwardly placed early, retreated. DARREN'S GIRL lacked speed, six wide late in the second turn, failed to rally. MARDI GRAS INDY dueled up front for six furlongs off the rail, stopped. THISHEARTSFORYOU tired five wide.
