Footnotes

TAKING A CHANCE forwardly placed along the inside, patiently handled through the turn while continuing to save all the ground, roused when straightened for home, challenged late inside the leader, in time. CROSSFIREHURRICANE narrowly set the pace, garnered a larger advantage in the turn, allowed the winner the rail, could not contain that foe in the waning strides, proved game for the place. PEACEFUL TOWN prompted the pace three wide, moved a bit closer turning for home, lacked a finishing kick. WILD ORATION behind the leaders, went evenly through the stretch. COUNTRY CAUCUS in some traffic early, continued between foes into the turn, fell back a bit late in the bend off the inside, moved out, also lacked a late response. DOLLY BONZ vied early while between foes, chased the runner up through the turn then gave way in the drive. CRAZYCOWBOYDREAM last away, trailed throughout in a dull effort.
