Footnotes

PROPER ONE patiently handled behind pace, brief wait behind a wall of horses into the lane, shifted out hit a hole three wide into the lane, split rivals, quickly clear. ANGELIC HANNAH lacked pace, saved ground through the turn, angled out steadily, up for the place, no threat to the winner. HAZEL DELL BELLE off the pace, advanced, challenged three wide into the lane, briefly showed the way past the furlong marker, no match for the winner, caught late for the place. LUCY'S COMING reared at the start, raced well back, angled out to be seven wide turning for home, improved position down the middle of the strip. OLETA bobbled at the start, quickly recovered to forced the issue, four wide into the lane, weakened. AMBER'S PROM behind the pace, fanned seven wide into the stretch, went evenly through the stretch in failing to menace. DAUGHTER'S LEGACY shied at the start, raced back, moved inside, improved slightly while also never dangerous. MYLITTLESWEETPEA narrowly showed the way toward the inside, weakened when headed turning for home. DIXIEBELL RING ON within striking distance, bumped into the turn, five out to six wide late in the bend, lugged in a bit when straightened for home, tired. MISS SEVENTY FIVE raced outside, continued four wide turn, failed to rally. EMILY WILL off slowly, was never involved. FATHER'S FAVORITE forwardly placed, bumped with a foe into the turn, gave way.
