HOLY PATOOIE broke alertly, soon got clear, turned back a pair of mild bids late in the turn, clear again stretch, lasted. MAIN MANN LEE lacked speed, behind horses into and through upper stretch, angled in briefly, altered course to the far outside with less than a furlong remaining, finished with a flourish to be up in time for the place. HIGHFLYERTOTHELINE broke in a bit, in the second flight, between foes late turn, roused for the drive toward the inside, missed the place. WIE EIN STEIN forwardly placed, tried the winner late in the turn, not good enough for that rival, closest to that same foe past the furlong marker, weakened a bit, not enough for the place. JENNY'S TOUCH void of speed, came six wide into the lane, lodged a modest close just inside the runner up. BARRAAQ lacked a response in the drive. TROPHY CASE forwardly placed, lodged a mild bid in the turn, gave way. ONE SUAVE CAT tired after a half.
