Footnotes

THE BIG WAVE gradually cleared to the inside the opening quarter, breather through the turn while continuing to show the way, clear midstretch, just enough left to last. SAINT'S RELIC lacked speed, moved out to be six wide out of the turn, set down, finished up willingly to just miss. ARCHIE TRUCKER prompted the pace, mild inside furlong marker, flattened out a bit, saved the show. DRINKS TO GO void of speed for four furlongs, began to move out of the turn, steered out to be widest midstretch, was going well at the end. DAAREB off the pace, steadied in tight quarters into the turn, four wide through the bend, went evenly down the lane. ZOOMING WHITE STAR broke out, off the pace and the inside, improved position slightly. HOLD'EM OR FOLD'EM within striking distance along the rail, shuffled back into the turn, moved a bit closer upper stretch, flattened out. CONDOBOUND prompted the pace, had little left for the drive. BIG CAL moved closer turn while five wide, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. ASHEN LORD was racing in midpack, checked up in tight quarters late backstretch, did not recover. CHOW WAGON pinched back start, trailed, was never close. SPIRIT OF WINTER in tight at the start, was finished after a half.
