TENSAW off the early pace, four wide when within striking distance in the second turn, roused a quarter out, vied through the stretch, proved narrowly best in determined fashion. FORTUNE AFAR bumped at the start, tracked the leaders from the outside, ranged up three wide to challenge late final turn, showed way into the lane, came in under a right handed stick with a sixteenth to run to tighten up both AVIATION SHOW and ALEJANDRO B, outfinished for the win. FOLLOWING A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF AVIATION SHOW AGAINST FORTUNE AFAR FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH AND A STEWARDS' INQUIRY, FORTUNE AFAR WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FIFTH. AVIATION SHOW off the pace but within striking distance, in traffic late in the final turn and into the lane, challenged along the rail with less than a furlong remaining, in tight late. ARTILLERY took back off a modest pace, continued back, angled out for the drive, finished willingly while too late out in the strip. ALEJANDRO B narrowly set the pace, vied into the lane, was beginning to tire a bit when put in tight by FORTUNE AFAR with a sixteenth to run, finished up evenly. MCHANGA pressured the leader outside that rival for six furlongs and faltered. NOAH AND O never a threat. TIZ OUR INSIGHT three wide and off the pace, continued in the second flight outside, had nothing for the drive.
