VUITTON outrun in the early going, swung out seven wide exiting the turn, finished with good late energy to be up in time. BEAT THE BLUES off the early pace, moved closer two out to three wide entering the stretch, took over, led late, nipped at the wire. LADY DIVA GA GA off the pace, floated out six wide into the stretch, bid, slight brush upper stretch, bid, not enough late. GOOD DEED moved up to duel up front soon after the start, weakened the final furlong. HOLY HEAVENS took back at the start, raced well back, enjoyed a good trip along the inside into the stretch, lacked the necessary closing response. ALL ABOUT ALLIE within striking distance, five wide into the lane, also had little to offer for the drive. AWESOME SYMMETRY forwardly placed, four wide exiting the turn, tired in the drive. MYSTERIOUS CHIMES asked early, dueled up front off the inside, stopped.
