Footnotes

ATREVIDO BANDITO rated while close and three wide through the first turn, stalked in the run up the backstretch, took over three wide far turn, widened. MICAHTUDE lacked speed, four wide into the lane, up for the place while no threat to the winner. INCLUSO void of early foot, came three wide into the lane, gained the nod for the show. HUNGARIAN CAT forwardly placed while saving ground, moved out a bit for the drive, lacked a late punch. ELEVEN GAGE evenly paced, came five wide into the stretch, continued evenly in the drive. VALSBOAT set or forced the pace for six furlongs, faltered in the drive. RED SASH moved up after the start, middle move on the outside into the far turn, faltered in the drive. LAYINMYBURDENSDOWN failed to menace. DIAMONDS IN DIXIE moved a bit closer into the far turn, gave way. CAVALRY PILOT remained always back. SIX GEMS showed the way early, stopped.
