BROTHERS NICHOLAS off the pace, advanced with a good gain through traffic in the second turn, bid between foes upper stretch, long drive, determined. SWEEPING PROMISES lacked speed, made a good gain into prominence turning for home., led, outfinished. SERVICE HAWK void of early foot, found best stride too late well out in the strip, up for the show. T. C. CHAMP within striking distance, three wide bid in the second turn, could not last. DU PARS clear through the first turn, set or forced the pace until a quarter remained, began to fade. SCOOTER D lacked a rally. ELLERTON off slow, raced far back, displayed some late interest well after the issue had been decided. CAMPTOWN KING remained back throughout. MOON KID forwardly placed, roused along the rail turning for home, stopped. LEXINGTON WIND chased the early leader, vied the middle half, stopped.
