BEAT THE BLUES allowed the pace to go early, in hand through the turn while within striking distance, challenged inside the leader nearing the furlong grounds, kicked clear. MYSTERIOUS CHIMES got quickly clear out of the chute, showed the way off the inside, had little to withstand the winner the final furlong, proved game for the place. GLEAMING within striking distance outside, raced four wide through the turn, roused for the drive, outside bid with a furlong to run, also could not match the winner late, outfinished for the place. SALTY STRIKE off the early pace, came four wide out of the turn, set down with a furlong remaining, failed to fire while well out in the strip at the wire. RATTLIN GYSPY last to leave, saved ground to no avail, evenly in the drive. WILD HOPE lacked speed, made little impact while racing off the inside. OMI'S VINDICATION pressured the early leader from the outside, began to give way before a half, continued to fade through the lane.
