ON FIRE BABY used a bit to clear soon after the start causing GRACE HALL to steady into the first turn, firmly rated up the backstretch to set a modest half mile split, responded when confronted midway on the final turn, shook clear when straightened for home, enough left to hold the runner up safe in the final strides. TIZ MIZ SUE allowed the pace to go early while saving ground, two path far turn, behind horses, briefly boxed late in the final turn, steered out five wide entering the stretch, late close, not enough in the final strides. DON'T TELL SOPHIA well back while three wide, moved closer four wide to briefly challenge late in the final turn, flattened out in the drive. SUMMER APPLAUSE closest to the leader, moved up to challenge between rivals midway on the second turn, began to weaken when the real running started at the head of the lane. BRYAN'S JEWEL broke to the outside, fell back to trail while still well off the inside, dropped inside for the drive, lacked clear room in some traffic a furlong out, finished up evenly. SHE'S ALL IN forwardly placed while racing in the three path, asked along far turn, little left for the drive. GRACE HALL steadied when toward the front when the winner angled in entering the first turn, within striking distance, ranged up to challenge on the outside far turn, gave way in the drive.
