BLACK BEAR broke alertly, got clear, rated in the two path around the turn, shaken up when straightened for home, well clear, ridden out in a sharp effort. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF EGYPTIAN WARRIOR AGAINST THE WINNER FOR INTERFERENCE LATE IN THE TURN WAS QUICKLY DISALLOWED. EGYPTIAN WARRIOR forwardly placed along the inside, steadied when in a bit tight along the rail late in the turn, moved out a bit for the drive, proved no match for the winner, proved game for the place. HARDROCK ELEVEN hit the gate, off slowly, six wide into the stretch, willingly late to miss the place. VANNISTELROOY STAR within striking distance off the inside, moved closer four wide late in the turn, flattened out the final furlong, not enough for the place. BOSS MAN ROCKET off the early pace, loomed a threat five wide turning for home, hung in the drive. MICO MARGARITA settled off the pace, behind horses through the stretch, failed to muster a rally. TWIN ENGINE void of early foot, saved ground turn, also came up empty for the drive. SILVER ANTELOPE pressured the winner in the early going from the outside, gave way. MANEWAL finished early.
