WILD EYED KENDAL took control after an alert break, set all the pace along the inside, not threatened in the drive to win ridden out. STORMY ARKY off the early pace, advanced from between foes late in the turn, four wide into the lane, closest to the winner upper stretch, could do little with that rival late, all out to hold the place. K J AND A HALF lacked speed, knifed out four wide turning into the stretch, set down, getting to the runner up late. SECRET RETURN fractious in the gate, unloaded out the front, reloaded, bit tight at the break, well back, six wide out of the turn, improved position a bit. AINT SHE A SHOES within striking distance early while racing off the inside, had little left for the drive. INDULGE ME tired from early efforts outside. RUSTY CODE retreated along the inside. CINNABEAN closest to the winner for a half, stopped in the drive. PRIMETIME KISS stumbled badly at the start, unseated rider.
