ILE ST. ROSIE cleared to the inside, set the pace, shook off the other speed out of the turn, driving. WAR BONNET forwardly placed, raced on the outside out of the turn, finished willingly to be clear for the place. SEVEN'S ROSE pressured the winner for a half, saved the show. STORMING RHEALEE went evenly paced throughout. HALFDRESSED lacked speed, improved position a bit while never dangerous. PROPER ROYALTY void of speed, came five wide out of the turn, passed tiring foes after the issue had been decided. GITCHAPOPCORNREADY last away, trailed early, in some traffic late in the turn, also picked off faltering rivals. WHY GO WEST had little for the drive. CINNAMON COWGIRL five wide through the turn, tired in the drive. MI CIELO CELEB middle of the pack, shuffled back along the rail into the turn, finished well back. SISSY PARTEE broke through the gate prior to the start, broke in good order, raced forwardly early, began a steady retreat before a half.
