QUE PASO back off the early pace, advanced four wide late in the turn, roused for the drive, finished willingly to be in time at the wire. CASEY'S ON CALL broke through the gate prior to the start, pressed the winner off the inside, took over and got clear, larger lead past the furlong marker, nipped at the wire. TALE OF A SAINT settled in the middle of the pace, moved closer off the inside late in the turn, flattened out a bit in the drive, gained the show. CRAFTY CAL forwardly placed while in hand, moved closer with a four wide bid turning for home, hung in the drive. CHANCE AND A HALF lacked speed, continued back into the lane, passed some tiring foes while never a threat. NOT SO FAST FESTUS back off the pace, seven wide turning into the lane, made little impact down the center of the strip. RED JUGGERNAUT lacked speed, six wide late in the turn, failed to rally. STRONG DREAM failed to menace after racing in the three path. GHOST CHAPEL within striking distance in the early going, steadily faded before a half. TROPHY CASE narrowly set the pace, gave way when headed turning for home.
