Supplementary nominations may be made by the closing time of entries at a fee of \$50,000 which qualifies to start with \$1,000,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the owner of the winner plus 100 Kentucky Derby points, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. WEIGHTS: Colts and Geldings 122 lbs.; Fillies 117 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes allowed 4 lbs. In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Early Bird closing Friday, February 8, 2013 at \$500 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2013 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. Closed Saturday, March 30, 2013 with 129 nominees.

Footnotes

OVERANALYZE unhurried in the early going while outside, maintained striking distance up the backstretch while widest, four out to five wide when advancing late in the second turn, collared the leader a furlong out, drifted in when clear, increased advantage late under steady handling. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE TRAINER OF FRAC DADDY AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN MIDSTRETCH WAS QUICKLY DISALLOWED. FRAC DADDY stalked the pace outside, four wide and inside the winner into the lane, no match for that foe the final sixteenth while drifting out slightly. CARVE reserved off the pace while racing in the two path, moved a bit closer after five furlongs, asked along late in the final turn, eased out a bit in traffic nearing the furlong marker, dropped inside, up late for the show along the rail. FALLING SKY away in good order, showed the way early then relinquished the advantage just before a quarter, regained lead, continued to lead into the stretch, weakened. OXBOW void of speed, improved in traffic late in the final

turn and into the stretch, lacked a serious late kick. DEN'S LEGACY behind the pace, lodged an early move between foes late backstretch, briefly vied, had little left for the drive. DIVINE AMBITION moved up inside to show the way after a quarter, vied, retreated in the drive. TEXAS BLING broke in, slight steady, five wide into the first turn, continued wide, five wide again in the second turn, failed to rally. HEAVEN'S RUNWAY broke alertly, raced forwardly for five furlongs and began to give way. WAR ACADEMY backed out of the gate prior to the start, reloaded, broke in good order, raced in mid pack toward the front, broke stride just after a half, pulled up gradually, walked off.
