Footnotes

HAYWORTH took over soon after the start, set all the pace just off the inside, drove well clear under firm handling. GRAB THE CAT off the early pace, moved closer while in a bit tight between foes turning for home, could not match the winner late, clear for the place. DON'T TELL TINA void of early foot, swung to the far outside for the drive, finished willingly while too late down the middle of the strip. ANNIEVILLE raced off the pace, loomed a threat four wide turning for home, brushed, hung. GOLDRUSH LADY forwardly placed and three wide, faltered in the drive. CRAFTY G forwardly placed for a half inside, tired from early efforts. BANKER'S BEAUTY pressed the early pace, steadily retreated.
