MASTER RICK pressured the soft pace off the inside, challenged between foes midway on the final turn, spirited duel into the lane, proved best late in a sharp effort. DRILL four wide and off the pace, joined the fray while continuing in the four path in the second turn, raced on equal terms with the winner past the furlong marker, could not keep up late. EXPLAIN bobbed just after the start, off the pace, loomed up five wide midway on the final turn, could not keep up with the top two the final furlong, saved the show. KING CORAL pulled while attempting to rate along the inside into the first turn, came in the two path turning for home, moved out a bit in the drive, gaining for the show spot late. DOUBLE RAH RAH away in good order, set a soft pace along the inside, gave way readily when replaced on the lead midway on the second turn.
