LAWYER RON broke in, bumped with foe, in a bit tight in the first turn, accelerated up the inside to outrun that traffic onto the backstretch, rated in the run up the backstretch though some lively fractions, remained clear, turned back a tepid bid from PRIVATE VOW nearing the furlong grounds while drifting in a bit under a steady right handed stick, increased advantage then held the runner up comfortably safe in the late going. STEPPENWOLFER lacked early foot, began a steady advance off the inside the third quarter while emerging from traffic, continued willingly to the finish while well off the inside. PRIVATE VOW prompted the winner up the backstretch, continued to chase through the second turn, lodged a mild bid on that on from the inside when straightened for home, was denied, weakened, caught for the place. SIMON PURE allowed to settle off the pace while three wide, moved a bit closer while four wide into the lane, flattened out a bit in the drive. NOB HILL DEELITE lacked speed, saved ground through the early part of the final turn, angled out for the stretch run, also went evenly to the wire. JEALOUS PROFIT in traffic through the first turn, settled, failed to rally in the drive. FILM FORTUNE void of early foot, improved position while not a serious threat. SAYHELLOTOLARRY lacked speed, advanced and got closest to the winner five wide turning for home, hung in the drive. HIGH COTTON broke out soundly bumping WITH A CITY, straightened, showed the way early, headed by the winner onto the backstretch, began to fade after five furlongs. RED RAYMOND, in traffic first turn, again second turn, remained back. SUPERFLY with the early pace outside, backed up.

NEW JOYSEY JEFF was always outrun. WITH A CITY bumped, offstrided at the start, moved up early, faded, far back..
