SYLVAN SAINT never far back while outside, moved up to engage the leader turning for home, long stretch dueled, edging away late in determined fashion. RUNNING SHOES with the pace from the start, garnered a larger advantage in the turn, gave ground grudgingly to the winner until late. POMEROY GIRL broke out, settled behind the leaders off the inside, continued one paced, no match for the top two. GAVE AWAY POWER bothered at the start, lacked speed, well back for a half, staged a mild rally while never dangerous. GET AN APPOINTMENT bumped, bothered at the start, trailed well back, passed tiring foes after the issue had been decided. FLEET SHOPPER bumped at the start, failed to rally. VINDICTIVE broke out, moved up inside to set the pace, got out into the turn, fell back, continued to fade. APPEALING VISION steadily faded.
