UNCLE BRENT never far back, moved up to challenge along the inside after a quarter, continued to save ground through the second turn, remained clear in the drive. ALBERGATTI forwardly placed early inside, moved out in the three path before a half, stalked, roused for the drive, slowly gaining on the winner late. DERIVATIVE got clear in the early going, showed the way onto the backstretch, pressed the winner through the second turn, weakened in the drive. THE OLE GEN off the inside, failed to respond when asked in the drive. ALSTOM last away, trailed, wide into the lane, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while not a serious threat. COMMANDER steadied in traffic in the first turn, saved ground, no factor. FAIRING was never a threat. ZARBY'S DERBY DAY chased early, steadily faded.
