CAT BRULAY stalked between horses then off the rail, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. FIERY TRIPPI sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, came out a bit in the stretch and held second. CAJUN GENT bumped at the start, chased between horses then off the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out into the stretch, waited momentarily off heels past midstretch then split rivals and gained the show. EISENHEIM close up stalking the pace inside then a bit off the rail on the turn, came out some in the stretch, drifted in late and was outfinished for a minor award. STAR TIME stalked the pace outside on the backstretch and turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. CONCERTO'S THUNDER stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in entering the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. MUST BE JOKING dropped back between foes then settled a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and was

not a threat. STRAY CAT wide early, settled outside, angled in alongside a rival into and on the turn and did not rally. HIYA SILVER stalked three deep then outside on the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and weakened. CAPTAIN CASH broke out and bumped a rival, settled between horses then outside a foe and lacked the needed response. O'FIVER broke a bit slowly, settled inside, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. QUICK J FINLAY unhurried a bit off the rail then outside a rival, was not a factor.
