SIX PACK ABS dueled between horses then outside a rival leaving the turn, took a short lead in the stretch and won clear under some left handed urging. CAYAMBE had speed between foes then dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but held second. NENE a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and just got the show five wide on the wire. FIVE STAR THIEF chased outside, went three deep leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and was edged for a minor award between foes late. MEN ONLY was in a good position stalking the pace inside, continued along the rail in the lane and also was edged for a minor award. TIME TO GET EVEN chased between horses then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. DARK NOSE dueled three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in some leaving the bend, drifted in a bit in the stretch, was between foes through much of the final furlong and weakened. WEEKEND ESCAPE (IRE) chased between horses then off the rail, split rivals into the stretch, was in a bit tight in midstretch and lacked the needed response.
