BABE HALL forced the pace outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, gained the advantage into the stretch and held on gamely between foes late under urging. TOPPISME prompted the pace between horses on the backstretch and turn, fought back along the rail in the stretch and went willingly to the wire. MY LITTLE MONKEY allowed to settle off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and finished well. CANDY JO off a bit slowly, moved up inside, set a pressured pace along the rail, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. STARK BEAUTY had good early speed between horses to press the pace, stalked a bit off the rail on the turn and also weakened. MISS FURY broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. BELLA GRACE steadied in tight between foes early, chased off the rail then outside a rival on the turn and weakened. MOON OVER HEMET had good early speed a bit off the rail, dueled between horses then stalked inside, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
