Footnotes

MOBILIZED chased between horses or off the rail, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. THE USUAL Q. T. stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and finished well between foes late. CANDY IS QUICKER sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, kicked away in the stretch and was caught late. TACTFUL chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and was outfinished late. TEAMWORK angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, moved up on the turn, came out in upper stretch and also finished with some interest. BEAUTEOUS MAXIMUS stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, was between foes again in midstretch and weakened. TOM QUINN was in a good position chasing the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and also weakened. SAINT JOHN settled between foes then off the rail, went four wide midway on the turn and three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. SPORT KING wide early, settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn and was not a factor. GRAZEN a bit slow to begin, angled in early, drifted out on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. LEAVETHEGATEOPEN wide early, chased outside then three deep, was fanned six wide into the stretch and had little left. POET KING stalked outside on

the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and gave way. TIZ AGAIN ROUSED broke alertly then dropped back wide early then off the rail and was outrun.
RIVER DANCE JOY between foes early, stalked outside a rival, dropped back fast on the turn and gave way.
