LIMITED CREOLE went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away into the turn then battled inside the runner-up on the turn, inched away again nearing the stretch and won clear under urging. SAVE a bit slow to begin, went up inside on the backstretch, went around a rival into the turn then bid outside the winner and dueled for the lead, was no match for that one in the stretch but held second. LAINIES LION chased off the rail then angled to the inside leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. PETER PAUL'N TANGO off a bit slowly then dropped back inside without early speed, continued along the rail and improved position in the stretch. VICTORY STYLE between foes early, stalked off the rail then angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. NATIONAL HONOR unhurried outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came between foes into the stretch and did not rally. ACOLYTE wide early, angled in outside a rival on the backstretch, was a bit off the rail on the turn and was not a threat. AFLEET SPY sped to the early lead off the rail then dueled outside the winner, dropped back into and on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and gave way.
