Footnotes

DIXIE CHATTER bobbled at the start, stalked outside a rival then between foes into and on the second turn, advanced toward the inside leaving that turn, came out in upper stretch, gained the lead between rivals in midstretch and inched clear under urging then held gamely. SALUTE THE SARGE stalked outside a rival then three deep, continued off the rail on the second turn and three wide into the stretch, bid outside foes in midstretch and went willingly to the wire. SHORE DO chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. BERESFORD chased inside then a bit off the fence, came out in midstretch and just missed third between foes late. DODGEN BULLETS had speed outside then angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, inched away on the backstretch, fought back on the second turn and inched clear again nearing the stretch, battled inside in midstretch and weakened late. DREWTHEGENTLEMAN prompted the pace between foes then outside a rival, stalked just off the rail on the backstretch, re-bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn and weakened in the lane. GUTS broke a bit slowly,angled in and settled inside then outside a rival, went up four wide midway on the second turn, angled in alongside a foe into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. YES IT'S A CAT chased between horses then outside a rival, continued between foes on the second turn, found the rail in the stretch and weakened. RIVERGRADE BOY close up stalking the pace inside, dropped back into and on the second turn and gave way.
