FINAL JOURNEY stalked four wide then three deep, continued outside on the turn, came out into the stretch, bid four across the track under some left handed urging in midstretch, put a head in front nearing the wire and gamely prevailed between foes on the line. CHARLIE AND CHRIS bobbled at the start, stalked inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, gained the advantage past the eighth pole, drifted out a bit in deep stretch and continued willingly late. BLACK KETTLE chased between horses or outside a rival, continued between foes leaving the turn, lacked room off heels from upper stretch until past the eighth pole, came out and surged late outside the top pair. DIXIE PASSION stalked between rivals then off the rail leaving the turn, came out into the stretch, gained the lead between foes nearing midstretch and weakened late. DEPUTY FLYER allowed to settle off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. EL ADELANTADO sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, came out into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch, was a bit crowded past the eighth pole, then weakened.
