Footnotes

SUMMER MOVIE stalked a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the second turn, took a short lead, fought back under urging along the inside in the stretch and held gamely. ROYAL F J wide early, went four wide into the first turn then stalked outside the winner, bid three deep on the second turn, fought back alongside the winner through the lane and continued willingly. SAINTLY SEOUL pulled a bit early, stalked outside, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and edged rivals for third between horses on the line. WORTH A PUNT saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals past midstretch and just missed the show. GUILTYBYASSOCIATION settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch, split horses past midstretch and put in a late bid at a minor award inside. WINDWALKER angled in and stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. RAPID HEAT chased outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. IRONMANN wide early, angled in and settled outside a rival or off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. ERBEIA settled outside a rival, went three deep into the second turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary rally. QUIETLY WAITING saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, angled back inside in the drive and did not rally. RECAP pulled early,

settled a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, angled out in upper stretch and was not a threat. BEAU MAVERICK sped to the early lead then pulled a bit while setting the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and gave way.
