Footnotes

SHE'S CHEEKY four wide early, stalked outside, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the lead and drew clear under some urging and steady handling. BLACK EYED LADY stalked between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, split rivals in midstretch and gained the show. STUTTGART chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and edged rivals for the show. HARD EIGHT close up stalking the pace inside, remained along the rail in the stretch and was edged for third. TASTE'S SIS chased between horses then outside a rival, came out into the stretch, split rivals in the drive and put in a late bid at a minor award. MADAME STRIKER a bit slow into stride, settled just off the rail then inside, continued on the fence in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. L' AZIZA bobbled slightly at the start, dueled between rivals then outside a foe, stalked leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. KENYA SKYE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away a bit off the rail leaving the turn, came out some into the stretch and also weakened.
