SMALL BUT MIGHTY stalked outside then off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch and held on gamely under urging. FRANGIPANNI hopped and threw her head at the start, chased between foes then went up three deep into the turn, continued just off the rail, bid between horses in midstretch and continued willingly while drifting in late. GLITTERMAN'S FANCY chased inside, split horses leaving the turn, bid along the rail in the stretch and edged a rival for third. MISS LYDIA chased inside then a bit off the rail, split rivals on the turn, came out into the stretch and was edged for the show. B. A. HOMEBODY a bit slow to begin, settled inside, swung out into the stretch and found her best stride late. BILLIE BOB bobbled at the start, angled in and dueled outside a rival then between foes leaving the turn and weakened. CASCABEL LADY broke out a bit, stalked off the rail, bid three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. PERFECTLY SWEET chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, came out into the

stretch and did not rally. A SONG AT TWILIGHT had good early speed and dueled inside to the stretch and weakened. STELLINA chased outside, went four wide into the turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. SHANGHI TANG stalked between foes then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and weakened. SUMMERSGOLDENGIRL hopped and broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail and failed to menace.
