**Footnotes**

GLOBAL HEAT angled in and chased inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, rallied under some urging and good handling to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. PRINCE REXY (AUS) a bit slow to begin, chased outside then three deep, angled in outside a rival into the stretch, bid between foes to put a head in front a sixteenth out and held second. NOWNOWNOW settled inside, came out on the second turn, swung three deep into the stretch and gained the show late. MORAL COMPASS chased inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. JOE BRAVO (BRZ) had good early speed and set the pace inside, opened up on the backstretch, remained clear past midstretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. KRIS SILVER chased three deep then angled in on the first turn, saved ground behind the pacesetter and lacked a response in the stretch. GABRIEL'S HILL between horses early, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace and did not rally. BRIGHT PREDICTION allowed to settle outside a rival, dropped back on the second turn and was not a threat. T'AIN T WAR SIR chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, continued outside a foe on the second turn and weakened.
