REALITY SHOW broke in a bit, took the lead and set the pace outside a rival then angled to the inside, inched away again in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. DEL MAR TICKET a bit crowded at the start, chased inside, waited some leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch, drifted in then out in the final furlong and was second best. TUFF MUFFIN broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail or outside the runner-up, came three deep into the stretch and gained the show. K'EHLEYR forced the early pace inside then stalked along the rail, came out leaving the first turn, bid outside the winner then between foes on the backstretch and second turn and weakened some in the final furlong. BALTIC DIP (IRE) bobbled a bit at the start, stalked outside then bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn, was between horses in midstretch and also weakened some.
