**Footnotes**

MISS DOW JONES had good early speed a bit off the rail then dueled between horses, battled outside a rival on the turn, gained the lead leaving the turn,

kicked clear in the stretch and held under urging. PERFECT VINTAGE chased outside, went five wide on the turn and three deep into the stretch and held second. SHOWTIME APOLLO settled outside then alongside a rival, came out five wide into the stretch and gained the show. UNBRIDLED PENNY settled off the rail, swung six wide into the stretch and found her best stride late. STITCHIT stalked the pace inside on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. DESERT SIREN went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. SAINT'S CROWN pulled between horses to duel for the lead, steadied in tight a half mile out, stalked between foes on the turn and weakened. IDEAL STORY chased between horses on the backstretch and outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. NIGHTNIGHTNIGHT dropped back wide then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground off the pace, moved up leaving the turn, steadied off heels leaving the turn, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. UNUSUALLY BRITE had speed between foes then stalked the pace, continued four wide between horses on the turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. LA CUBANITA dueled between rivals then stalked between foes into and on the turn and also weakened. REEL DANGER also dueled between horses three deep then stalked between rivals on the turn, dropped back nearing the stretch and weakened. GULCHSTREAM stalked between rivals then angled in on the turn and had little left for the stretch. WARREN'S HONEY chased inside on the backstretch and turn, fell back approaching the stretch and gave way.
