Footnotes

BROMOS LEAD CHANGE prompted the pace four wide on the backstretch and into the turn, took the lead outside the runner-up into the stretch and drew clear under a crack of the whip and steady handling. NANCYLAND vied for command three deep between horses, angled in leaving the turn, could not match the winner in the stretch but held the place. LOST MEMO off a bit slowly, settled toward the inside, split horses into the turn, came three deep into the

stretch and gained the show. TRUE AND FAITHFUL chased outside then alongside a rival on the turn, came out leaving the bend, was fanned five wide nearing the stretch, angled in some and lacked the needed rally. RICH VENUS chased five wide on the backstretch and six wide into and on the turn and into the stretch, drifted in and improved position but was not a threat. HARLEM ANGEL chased between horses on the backstretch, angled in some on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and failed to menace. PLAYFUL BLINT settled off the rail early, went five wide between horses into the turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a factor. HEAVONS CAPER broke slowly, went between horses to chase the pace on the backstretch, continued three deep on the turn and was not a threat. FUZZY CHAI chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, fell back some into the stretch and lacked a further response. SAME OL' LOVE sent inside to duel for the lead, dropped back leaving the turn, came out some into the stretch, drifted inward in midstretch and weakened. KICKIN STARS stalked the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, steadied off heels in midstretch and had little left. ST. AMAND sent between horses to duel for command, lugged out badly leaving the turn to come five wide into the stretch, gave way and was pulled up in the stretch.
