All horses shall pay \$5,000 additional to start, with \$400,000 guaranteed and an additional \$100,000 from Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host associations's money to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert to the Fund. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner.

LAVA MAN gradually angled to the inside in the run to the first turn, dueled inside rivals, inched clear on the second turn and proved best under urging. BROTHER DEREK stalked the early pace outside then bid three deep on the backstretch to duel for command, continued outside a rival on the second turn and through much of the stretch and held second. GIACOMO unhurried off the rail to the second turn, went around a rival on that turn, came out in the stretch and just got the show. PREACHINATTHEBAR dueled outside the winner then between foes on the backstretch and to the middle of the second turn, angled in nearing the stretch and weakened but lost third late. SUPER FROLIC stalked the dueling leaders between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and lacked the needed response. MAGNUM (ARG) close up stalking the pace three deep, continued outside on the second turn and into the stretch, drifted in through the drive and weakened. ROMEO PLUS (ARG) tracked the leaders along the inside, dropped back on the second turn, came out a bit into the stretch and gave way.
