Footnotes

RAILROAD broke inward, chased inside, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and rallied under some urging to gain the lead in deep stretch, then pulled clear. GREAT ACTION stalked the pace outside a rival, bid three deep into the stretch, took the lead in upper stretch, drifted in and just held second. KEG TAP a bit crowded at the start, chased outside, advanced three deep leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch and finished well. DARK INDULGENCE chased inside, came out into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive and lacked the needed late kick. MARGARITALOSFLORES steadied

when squeezed at the start, settled outside then off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and improved position. KLAMATHFALLSASLEEP chased outside then three deep on the hill, drifted five wide into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. ZULU DANCER between horses early, settled inside, came out in the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. MIGHTY WILL angled in and dueled outside a rival, was between foes in upper stretch and weakened. GENERAL ANTONIO bobbed at the start, angled in and dueled inside, fought back leaving the hill but also weakened in the drive. NATURAL PHENOMENON chased outside then between horses leaving the hill, angled inward in the stretch and did not rally, then was a bit crowded in deep stretch. CHANT FOR GOLD settled between horses chasing the pace, came out four wide into the stretch and weakened.
