FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$250 each if made on or before Thursday, September 1, 2005.

Closed with 29. All horses shall pay \$2,500 additional to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed and an additional \$50,000 from Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host association's money to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert to the Fund. Three-Year-Olds: 121. Older: 123 lbs. Non-winners of two races of \$100,000 at One Mile or over in 2005 allowed 2 lbs.; one race of \$100,000 at One Mile of over in 2005, 4lbs. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. (Rail at 8 feet).

Footnotes

SINGLETARY pulled between horses early, angled in and chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, angled out again in upper stretch and rallied gamely under a steady hand ride until the final stages to prove best. DESIGNED FOR LUCK stalked the pace outside a rival, bid outside the pacesetter on the second turn, gained the advantage in the stretch, could not match the winner late but held second. BUCKLAND MANOR pulled his way along between horses early, chased between foes then a bit off the rail on the second turn, was between rivals again in the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. WE ALL LOVE ALEYNA stalked the pace inside, lacked room off heels through much of the drive, steadied in deep stretch then bumped a rival when between foes at the wire. WILD BUDDY took the early lead and set the pace inside, fought back along the rail on the second turn and in the stretch, was bumped late and outfinished. KING OF HAPPINESS was in a good position stalking the pace three deep then outside a rival on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened.
