HEIR JOE unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, advanced three deep on the turn, gained the lead under left handed urging outside rivals in deep stretch and proved best. PEACOCK ALLIANCE stalked outside then bid alongside the pacesetter a half mile out, tracked that one on the turn, re-bid alongside that rival in the stretch, gained a slim lead, was between foes a sixteenth out and could not hold off the winner. POKER TRICK sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, inched away again on the turn, fought back in the stretch and weakened late but held third. VEECU chased between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out some into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. STRIKINGLY SINFUL settled outside chasing the pace, split horses on the turn, swung out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. FAMILIAR SHINE had good early speed and stalked inside, remained along the rail in the stretch and weakened. LUV DRAGON saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. FACE AND AN ACE chased between horses, dropped back off the rail into the turn, angled in nearing the stretch and gave way.
