RED OPAL (IRE) chased outside then three deep down the hill, came five wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up four wide on the wire. SHE'S NOBLE settled off the rail then chased outside, continued between foes leaving the hill and outside a rival into the stretch and surged between foes late to just miss. GLASSY a bit slow to begin, went up inside on the hill, came out some in the stretch and also surged between foes late. COTORRA settled off the rail then angled in and stalked the pace inside, bid along the rail in the stretch and went willingly to the wire. UDRIGA sped to the early lead, dueled inside a rival then inched away off the rail, continued just off the fence in the stretch and held on well but was caught between horses late. ARGENTINISIMA (ARG) pulled her way along outside a rival and was in a bit tight at the right hand curve, prompted the pace outside a foe then stalked off the inside, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. CHAMPAGNE GIRL cut the corner at the right hand curve, stalked off the inside then three deep on the hill, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
