TOUR DA BRONX stalked off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, gained the lead outside the pacesetter nearing midstretch and pulled clear under a brisk hand ride until the late stages. BERTIE BOY saved ground chasing the pace, came out between horses into the stretch and edged a rival late for second. GARY'S GOT RHYTHM stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid outside a rival leaving the second turn and between horses into the stretch, drifted in some and was edged late for the place. ECHEZEAX a bit washy at the gate, went three deep into the first turn, chased between horses then outside a rival on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ALIE'S DIN DIN angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. THE SUPPLY PROGRAM settled outside a rival then three deep, continued off the rail on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and failed to menace. GET OFF THE SUGAR sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
