Footnotes

YES IT'S A CAT sped between horses to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then inside, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under some left handed urging and steady handling. LUCKY HONEY chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, split rivals in the stretch and gained the place. HONOURAMONGFRIENDS angled in and stalked the pace inside, remained along the rail in the stretch and just held third. FIRE BREAK chased four wide then outside foes, continued alongside a rival on the turn and three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. DRY MAN'S GULCH close up stalking the pace outside a rival, weakened some in the final furlong. NENE settled off the rail, went three deep into and out of the turn and lacked the needed rally. ZETTERBERG went up inside to stalk the pace, steadied in tight into the turn, remained along the rail and lacked the necessary late kick. HIGH STAKES SILVER chased between foes then a bit off the rail, split horses leaving the turn and could not summon the needed response.
