IRON DUKE chased between horses then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and surged between rivals under urging late to get up. CINDER CONE dueled inside, put a head in front in the stretch and held on well but was edged late. BALLESTERO stalked outside a rival then between horses, continued off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and finished willingly. MANDATE TO FLY angled in and set a pressured pace outside the runner-up, drifted out a bit in midstretch, fought back in the final furlong and was between horses late. VICE ADMIRAL chased between horses then a bit off the rail, split rivals in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. PEACHY CANYON chased outside a rival, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. LIL MITCH pulled early, chased inside, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and made up some ground but was not a serious threat. MORE ORE three deep on the first turn, chased outside, angled in some on the second turn, came out onto foes in midstretch and could not summon the needed rally. SURF TOWN stalked the pace three deep, continued three wide on the second turn and into the stretch, steadied when bumped in midstretch and weakened. MASTER HEAT a bit slow to begin, angled in and saved ground off the pace, was pulled up in upper stretch and vanned off.
