Footnotes

WESTERLY MAGIC saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and rallied under some late urging and good handling to get up three deep late. ROMP (ARG) broke a bit slowly, pulled some when off the rail early, angled in on the first turn and saved ground then rallied along the inside in the stretch. BOULE D'OR (IRE) off a bit slowly, slipped through inside on the first turn to take the lead, set the pace along the rail, came off the fence in the stretch and held on well but was outfinished between foes late. NEW EXPORT (BRZ) chased outside a rival, angled to the inside entering the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late response. THE BIG ONE pulled his way to the early lead inside, came off the rail into the first turn, stalked just off the inside then outside the winner leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. DADSALITTLEUNUSUAL stalked the pace between horses to the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FIRE WOOD pulled early, stalked off the rail then three deep into and on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch.
