Footnotes

BELLA BANISSA cut the corner at the right hand curve, set the pace outside a rival then inched away and angled in on the hill and held on gamely under urging. SPY ALY prompted the early pace a bit off the rail then stalked inside, came out some in midstretch and edged a rival for second. QUEMAR (NZ) chased off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and was edged for the place. NIQUITA (BRZ) was in a good position chasing the pace between horses, continued a bit off the rail in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. FEEL RIDGE (BRZ) well placed stalking the winner three deep on the hill, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FAN TIME stalked off the rail then outside the runner-up down the hill and weakened in the stretch. SWEET AMBITION chased inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and lacked the necessary response. HOTESSE (CHI) bobbled slightly at the start, settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and was not a threat. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
